

We use cookies in order to provide a better service and give you a better browsing experience. We want to inform you clearly and precisely about the cookies we use. Below we detail what a cookie is, what it is used for, what types of cookies we use, what their purpose is and how you can configure or disable them if you wish.

What is a cookie and what is it used for?

A "Cookie" is a small file that is stored on the user's PC, Tablet, Smartphone or any other device with information about navigation. The cookie is used to collect information and provide it to the Platform in order to be configured to give a certain configuration, or for statistical purposes, or for the purpose of access security configuration.

What types of cookies do we use?

Our own Cookies

They are those that are sent to your computer from the servers from which we provide the service you request.

Third party cookies

They are those that are sent to your computer from a computer or domain that is not managed by ANF AC, but by another collaborating entity. You can find out about transfers to third countries, if any, made by third parties identified in this cookie policy in their corresponding policies: <u>Google Analytics</u> and <u>MonsterInsights</u>

Depending on the period of time they are activated on your equipment

Session Cookies

They are temporary cookies that remain in the cookie folder of your browser until you leave the website, so that none is recorded on the hard drive of your terminal. The information obtained through these cookies is used to analyze web traffic patterns. In the long run, this allows us to provide a better browsing experience.

Persistent Cookies

They are stored in the persistent memory of your terminal and our Platform reads them each time you make a new visit. A persistent cookie has a specific expiration date. The cookie will stop working after that date. We generally use these cookies to facilitate the purchase and registration services. On www.anf.es cookies have a maximum duration of 16 months.

By purpose

Technical Cookies

These cookies do not store personally identifiable information. They are those necessary for navigation and the proper functioning of our Platform. They allow, for example, to control traffic and data communication, access restricted areas, make the purchase process of an order, use security features, store content to broadcast videos or share content through social networks. You can configure your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but disabling them may cause problems accessing or browsing our platform, some areas of the site will not work.

Personalization cookies

They are those that allow you to access the service with some predefined characteristics depending on a number of criteria, such as language, the type of browser through which you access the service, monitor

settings, the locale from which you access the service, etc.. These cookies allow the website to provide better functionality and personalization. If you do not allow the use of these cookies, it is possible that some of these services may not work properly.

Analytics Cookies

They are those that allow us to quantify the number of users and thus perform the measurement and statistical analysis of the use made by users of the services provided, pages visited, as well as time spent. To do this, your browsing is analyzed in order to improve content, and the supply of products and services. We also use analysis cookies for device recognition and fraud prevention in certain transactions.

Advertising Cookies

They are those that allow the management of advertising spaces that could be included on our website. These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources. They can be used by these companies to create a profile of your interests and show you relevant ads on other sites. All information these cookies collect is anonymous, they do not directly store personal information, but are based on the unique identification of your browser and Internet device. If you do not allow these cookies to be used, you will see less targeted advertising.

Behavioral advertising cookies

These cookies store information about user behavior. They do not directly store personal information, but are based on the unique identification of your browser and Internet terminal. They can be used to create a profile of your interests and show you relevant advertisements on other sites. Thanks to them, we can show you advertising or information related to your browsing profile. If you do not allow the use of these cookies, you will see less targeted advertising.

Sending IP addresses and Cookies

Our web pages automatically record the IP address, country of origin, day and time, and the link from which you accessed our website, all for purely statistical purposes, or information security.

In addition, we inform you that cookies are used on this website in order to analyze electronic communications of the navigation, as well as in order to provide or enable the services or features requested by you. These cookies:

- Remember the language preference indicated.
- They increase the security of navigation on our website.
- They allow the navigation to be carried out more easily.
- They make possible the reproduction of multimedia contents.

This website also uses its own cookies, designed to collect information about users' browsing, strictly for statistical purposes, to improve its functionality and security. Their use allows us to:

- To know the number of visitors to the "ANF AC" portal.
- To count the number of visits in each of the different pages of this portal.
- To know the activity in the portal for the identification of problems and improvements in navigation.

You can deactivate the use of cookies at any time by modifying the configuration parameters of your browser, although we warn that those associated with security, e.g. session keys, may affect the functionality of the site:
